# **Concussion Management**

- Develop personalized recovery programs following concussion based on patient's symptoms. We evaluate and treat vestibular and ocular motor dysfunction, headaches, cervical spine and perform exertional testing.

# **Functional Dry Needling**

- Treatment technique that inserts a thin, dry needle into trigger points to reduce pain and treat musculoskeletal dysfunction. May use additional modality of electrical stimulation. Differs from acupuncture as dry needling is based on modern evidence-based science and does not follow the traditional eastern medicine philosophy of energy flow, gi and meridian lines.

- Complete decongestive therapy utilizing manual lymph drainage and short stretch bandaging, and aide in obtaining compression garments.
